1. About this document

This target market determination (TMD) seeks to offer consumers, distributors and staff with an understanding of the class of consumers for which this product has been designed, having regard to the objectives, financial situation and needs of the target market.

This TMD applies to the Tactical Income Active ETF issued by Janus Henderson Investors (Australia) Funds Management Limited (ABN 43 164 177 244) referred to in the Tactical Income Active ETF Product Disclosure Statement.

2. Class of consumers that fall within this target market

The information below summarises the overall class of consumers that fall within the target market for the Tactical Income Active ETF, based on the product key attributes and the objectives, financial situation and needs that this product has been designed to meet.

A consumer (or class of consumer) might intend to hold a particular investment product as part of a diversified portfolio. In these scenarios, the investment product should be assessed against the consumer's attributes for the applicable part of the portfolio, instead of against the consumer's portfolio as a whole.

The Tactical Income Active ETF is for those who are seeking to adopt a tactical investment approach with regular asset allocation shifts between cash, fixed interest and higher yielding securities to reflect all stages of the interest rate and credit cycle.

Product description and key attributes

The key product attributes of the Tactical Income Active ETF are:

- Tactical Income Active ETF seeks to achieve a total return after fees that exceeds the total return of the Benchmark (Bloomberg AusBond Bank Bill Index and Bloomberg Ausbond Composite 0+ Yr Index, equally weighted);
- The fund gains its exposure by investing in a range of Janus Henderson's local fixed interest funds. This provides investors with a highly diversified exposure to a wide range of cash, cash equivalent, short and longer duration fixed interest securities and higher yielding securities;
- Income distributions are generally made on a quarterly basis;
- A management fee of 0.45% per annum of the asset value of the fund is charged; and
- As a traded security, investors are able to enter and exit the investment anytime on the Cboe Australia Exchange during trading hours.

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Objectives, financial situation, and needs

This product has been designed for individuals who:

- Are seeking capital preservation and income distribution through exposure to fixed interest and other higher yielding securities;
- Are willing to pay the fund's management fee through the value of their invested capital;
- Would be comfortable to invest their capital for a minimum suggested timeframe of at least three years;
- Have a low-medium risk tolerance and are willing to accept the risks of losing some of their invested capital; and
- Need this product if they are wanting to gain exposure to an actively managed diversified fixed income strategy that aims to outperform the benchmark.

Consistency between target market and the product

The Tactical Income Active ETF is likely to be consistent with the likely objectives, financial situation and needs of the class of consumers in the target market. This is based on an analysis of the key terms, features and attributes of the product and a finding that these are consistent with the identified class of consumers. Individuals will need to consider whether this product meets their specific objectives, financial situation and needs. The fund aims to meet its performance target as assessed in relation to its objective and benchmark, and also aims to pay quarterly distributions.

Platforms	The fund is available for distribution through investment, super or wrap platforms, and investor directed portfolio service (IDPS) or IDPS-like scheme or other trading platform provided there is an arrangement between the issuer and platform which governs their relationship.
Advisers	The fund is available for distribution through a dealer group and/or a registered financial adviser either directly or via platforms where the dealer group and/or financial adviser has considered the customer's objectives, financial situation and needs, and is reasonably satisfied that the fund, or a diversified portfolio containing this fund is suitable for the customer.
